NF Network and its member organizations are eternally grateful to those individuals who help support our mission and secure our initiatives for years to come.





What is **NF?**

Neurofibromatoses (NF) are genetic disorders of the nervous system which cause tumors to form on the covering of the nerves anywhere in the body at any time. They are progressive disorders which affect all races and both sexes equally, and may be associated with tumor growth, deafness, blindness, disfigurement, bone deformities, learning disorders and cancer.
